We are the only charity that works across every area of every cancer.

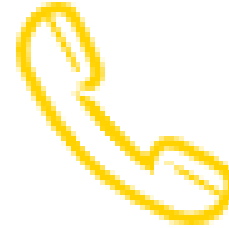
